Walker Tompkins in his book "Goleta, the Good Land" reports that the non-denominational Rafaela Cemetery Association was formed in 1874 embracing almost 6 acres east of the La Goleta Rancho and north of Hollister Avenue, serving the same area as the Rafaela School District. In 1910 this was changed to the Goleta Public Cemetery District, a County entity, embracing 12 acres from Ellwood Cooper's ranch on the west to San Roque Creek on the east.
